Statement of Lynn Hastings, United Nations Resident and Humanitarian Coordinator in the Occupied Palestinian Territory

We find ourselves at a very special time and place, when the Holy month of Ramadan and celebrations of Passover and Easter coincide. This should be a time for peace. Instead, both Palestinians and Israelis have recently, and tragically, lost their lives or loved ones.

Continued failure to adhere to international law will only lead to a deterioration of an already fragile security situation. We must all work together towards de-escalation. Voices that promote peace are needed, alongside swift and thorough investigations and accountability for all actions.
